- Explore modern front end technologies, build playful and experimental interactions, and design unique solutions for a wide range of projects.
- Work with diverse clients, including artists, non-profits, and groups from marginalized communities.
- Collaborate directly with clients to synthesize and prioritize website goals for usability, engagement, design fidelity, and user experience.

Selected projects:

My Heart My Body (Sailor Moon) — Immersive, playful installation for Gray Area. Used p5.js and TensorFlow.js to create an interactive experience that lets users strike poses to transform into superheroes.

University of Minnesota — An editorial “scrollytelling” feature for an online exhibit. Developed custom functions in Javascript and wrapped them in a Wordpress plugin to facilitate close readings of historical documents.

Mills College — Website for 580 Split, Mills College’s literary journal. I created the information architecture to access and organize the articles, poems and interviews for each issue, and edited the WordPress dashboard for easy admin setup but also restricted volunteer access.
